Epiphany: God Revealed, Still with Us

Dear Friends in Christ,

Each year on January 6th, the Church celebrates Epiphany – a word that means “manifestation” or “revealing.” On this day, we remember the visit of the Magi, the outsiders from afar who followed a star and discovered that God had chosen to be revealed not in a place, but in a child – Christ, born for the sake of the whole world.

Epiphany is not just about a moment in the past. It is about a truth that continues to shape our lives: God is revealed in unexpected places, to unexpected people, in unexpected ways. God’s light shines not only in times of clarity and stability, but also in seasons of transition, uncertainty, and change.

As a congregation, we know something about change. Staffing shifts, new rhythms, and unanswered questions can leave us wondering what comes next. Epiphany reminds us that God is not absent in these moments. The same God who guided by starlight is still guiding the Church today – sometimes clearly, sometimes quietly, but always faithfully.

The Epiphany season stretches beyond a single day, carrying us through the weeks that follow. During this time, we hear stories of Jesus being revealed; at his baptism, in his teaching, in acts of healing, and in ordinary encounters with people longing for hope. These stories proclaim a steady promise: God is with us, here, now, and still at work among us.

This season also invites us to pay attention. The Magi had looked up. They had to notice. They had to stop and listen. In much the same way, Epiphany calls us to create space in our lives to watch for God’s presence – especially when life feels unsettled.

One of the simplest and most faithful ways we do this is through prayer. Prayer does not need to be complicated or eloquent. It can be as a breath, as honest as a sigh, or as quiet as sitting in silence. During this season, I invite you to open your heart to God at least once a day – whether through spoken prayer, scripture, or a few moments of silence. Even five minutes of stillness can help us remember that we are not carrying life alone.

Prayer is not about convincing God to be near; God is already present with you. Prayer simply helps us become aware of that presence. It roots us in grace, steadies us during change, and opens us to the light God continues to reveal.

As we move through Epiphany together, may we trust that God is guiding this congregation just as surely as that ancient star. May we notice the light along the way. And may we remember, in every season, that Christ is revealed for us – and still walks with us!

Council Update

Dear Members of Our Saviors,

Your church council met for the final time in 2025 on Tuesday. Amidst the season of Advent, a time of expectant hope, we found reason to be hopeful. During the week where we lit the candle of Joy, we had time to celebrate. And in the final weeks of the year, we're able to look to the coming year.

We wrapped up our visioning with the final chapter of Anatomy of a Revived Church. Over the course of this book, we've been challenged to look at what it might take, what other churches have done, have changed, in order to revitalize the church. There are challenges, there are opportunities, and there are reasons to celebrate Our Saviors. Throughout our discussions, our town halls, and even more evident from the State of the Church, we've asked you to be open, honest, and vulnerable, and much of the discussion had and feedback we've received is that there are changes that Our Saviors may be asked or may need to consider making.

Change was the recurring theme of our meeting. We continue to amend the Ministry Spending Plan. Last month, our preliminary MSP had a deficit of \$110,000, and we knew we couldn't bring that forward. Additional pledges have come in, which we're grateful for, and we've been able to have frank and deliberate discussions about where we're at and where we're heading, and that's helped us in improving the MSP.

Another change we've encountered is in reduced pastoral staff. We have talked with the Synod office, and we will be bringing in Pulpit Supply to help Pr. Kira with ministry and preaching while we discern the next steps. There will also be a change in how we share the Lord's Supper together. Rather than the 1st and 3rd weeks of the month, as we've been doing, beginning next year, we will have Communion on the 3rd and 4th weeks of the month.

And yet, amidst change, there is something to be said for tradition as well, and what's Advent and the Christmas season without a children's performance. We want to thank the kids, the actors and the singers, for their CAKE performance, showing all of us how, not only in the season of Advent, but throughout the year, this congregation continually provides and embodies the Christmas Acts of Kindness in how when we give of our time, our gifts, our talents, in how we give of ourselves, we're giving Christ to others. We also want, again, to thank and congratulate Ashley on her first Christmas program along with the many youth volunteers that helped lead, teach and guide our kids.

Thank you, dear people of our expectant Savior, for sharing in the mission and ministry of Our Saviors.

November was such a wonderful month and it's such a blessing to be heading into December at \$14,428!!


