Dear Friends in Christ,

Pastor Craig Breimhorst always said that "we are Easter people." He always spoke those words with conviction and deep joy. It radiated through his being to claim those words for his life! To say we are Easter people is to say that resurrection shapes how we live, not just one Sunday in April, but every day of our lives. It is a simple sentence and it carries enormous meaning for our life of faith.

Easter people believe that God is always at work, bringing life where the world might expect endings. For us, resurrection is not just something that happened to Jesus long ago. It is the beginning of the new life for all of us that God continues to bring into our world every day.

As we come to the end of the Christian education year together, my first with you, I find myself reflecting on what it means that this congregation is an Easter people. One of the great joys of this year has been watching Faith come alive, not only in classrooms or confirmation lessons, but in the everyday lives of this community as they serve their church and their world.

I have seen it in the way families make space for Faith conversations at home. I have seen it in confirmand, asking thoughtful questions and wrestling honestly with what it means to follow Jesus. I have seen it in the way people show up for one another bringing meals, sitting in hospital, rooms, offering quiet, prayer, and walking besides friend and neighbors through seasons of grief and transition. I have seen it in the way individuals are re-investing in this community as a point of connection and relationships.

This is what Faith looks like in the real world.

The gospel of John tells us that when Mary Magdalene encountered the risen Jesus, she was sent out with good news to share. Resurrection always sends us outward. It invites us to live differently, to be people of hope in whatever comes your way today!

As we wrap up this year of learning and anticipate what is next, I want you to know what a delight it has been to witness this congregation living as Easter people. Faith is not something you are keeping inside the walls of our church. It is something you are all carrying into your homes, work, relationships, and communities.

The risen, Christ continues to meet us, guide us, and call us forward as we look toward the months ahead. My prayer is that we continue to grow into the people God is shaping us to be. People in resurrection who care deeply for one another and who live out Christ's love in every corner of our lives because we are, indeed, Easter people. And that changes everything.

Council Corner

On March 17th, the Church Council held its first regular meeting of the new term. In our continuing commitment to transparency with you, the congregation, we will continue to highlight what takes place at Council meetings with Temple Talks and Council Corners in the newsletter. Also, we will begin making the approved minutes of the council meeting available to the congregation. Copies of the minutes for the February meeting will be available in the Narthex if you'd like a copy.

The weekend prior to our Council meeting, a number of our council members gathered with other council leadership throughout our Synod for the Council as Leaders 2026 gathering in Austin. Attendees had the opportunity to attend workshops and seminars focused on being an effective Council and leaders, and partake in discussion about being good stewards of the church, and engaging and re-engaging congregation members. It reinforced much of the conversation we've had, as a church, as of late through our roundtables, about civic engagement, looking at who we are as a congregation, and how we get to who we hope to be, which ties our theme from last year of reviving the church to our goal this year of moving everyone from a seat in the pew to active membership.

For those looking for a way to get involved, the Spring Table, in particular, is looking for additional members. If you have an interest, please reach out to Pr. Kira or a council member, specifically Micah Lynn and Barb Condit, who are the Council representatives on the Spring Table. The Spring Table is also looking for input on new nonprofits and organizations to support. While we have limited our funding of benevolence per the Ministry Spending Plan (the Budget), we know this is still a generous congregation that wants support the organizations that support our community and beyond.

As testament to your generous spirit, we want to share that two months into the year, our giving is ahead of our MSP. It's been a financial goal to be able to have 2 to 3 months of operational funds on deposit, and thanks to a strong and generous end to 2025 which has carried over into 2026, we have nearly 4 months of operational funds available. It is worth noting that this is also because of being down the positions we are, and we are still discerning and discussing the staffing structure best suited for OSLC moving ahead.

As we've also contemplated a means of using our space more effectively, we do want to share that we have received notice that the Ruth's House office by the Prairie Avenue will be vacating their space at the end of April. This organization, with a long history tied to Our Saviors has outgrown the space, and we want to celebrate them for the incredible impact they have in our community and wish them well with their new space.

It's our goal that everyone find a space, a place at Our Saviors and have the sense that they belong here, because you do. If you want to get more involved, we want to help you in doing so.

Visits are generally once a month for about an hour, with the meeting time being determined by each companion. Those who have served as companions talk about how enriching it is to visit others, pray for them, and keep them connected to the congregation through the sacrament of Holy Communion.
